As an artist, gerontologist, and educator, she frequently speaks on the intersection of the arts, dementia, and intergenerational service learning and has published in these areas. She has presented her work in North America, Europe and Asia. She is a fiber artist and is also a Master Teaching Artist with the National Center for Creative Aging.
